If any candidate is not satisfied with measurement of his/her physical standard, he/she can prefer appeal on the same day to the PO recruitment board against rejection in physical measurement. Such candidates will be given a fresh date by the Presiding Officer of the recruitment board for appearing for re-measurement by the appellate authority. The decision of the appellate authority in this regard will be final. If the candidate is found to be within the prescribed standard, he/she will be forwarded to next selection process in continuation.	If any candidate is not satisfied with measurement of his/her physical standard, he/she can prefer appeal on the same day to the nominated appellate authority of GC(Recruitment Centre) against rejection in physical measurement. Such candidates will be given a fresh date and time by the appellate authority for appearing for re-measurement. Appellate authority is at liberty to dispose the appeal on the same day. The decision of the appellate authority in this regard will be final. If the candidate is found to be within the prescribed standard, he/she will be forwarded to next selection process in continuation.
