

## NOTICE

Due to revision of uniform guidelines for Review Medical Examination(RME) in CAPFs & AR vide MHA OM No. E-32012/ADG(Med)/DME & RME/DA-I/2020 (Part File)/1166 dated 31/05/21, the following amendments now made in para-C : APPEAL AGAINST MEDICAL EXAMINATION under Stage-IV : Medical Examination (at page No. 22) in notification/advertisement dated 25/06/20 for Paramedical Staff Examination-2020.

<b>For</b>	<b>Read</b>
<p><b><u>C. APPEAL AGAINST MEDICAL EXAMINATION:</u></b></p> <p>If a candidate is declared “UNFIT” in medical examination, the grounds for rejection/unfitness will be communicated to the candidate by recruiting doctor duly countersigned by PO of the Recruitment Board. The candidate, if not satisfied with the findings of the recruiting doctor, can submit appeal for review medical examination (RME) with a certificate, indicating of error of judgment, of his medical fitness from a Medical Officers of concerned specialist from district hospital and above along with registration no given by MCI/ State medical council practitioner and fee of Rs. 25/- to the Appellate Authority. The medical certificate or proof will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the Medical Officer concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been declared unfit for service by CRPF recruiting medical board for appointment in CRPF. The appeal will also be not taken into consideration unless it contains medical re-examination fee of Rs.25/-(Rupees Twenty Five) only in the form of crossed IPO/Demand Draft in favour of the Appellate Authority which is submitted <b>within 15 days</b> from the date of issue of the communication of his medical unfitness. The Appellate Authority for the purpose will be intimated to the concerned candidates in due course.</p> <p>The candidates, whose appeals are accepted by the appellate authority, shall be directed to appear before Review Medical Board (RMB) giving them specific date, time and venue well in time.</p>	<p><b><u>C. APPEAL AGAINST MEDICAL EXAMINATION:</u></b></p> <p>All candidates declared unfit during Detailed Medical Examination(DME) will be allowed to undergo Review Medical Examination(RME), provided they give their written consent by appending their signature on the intimation indicating the reasons for being unfit.</p> <p>The consent for RME duly signed by the candidate should be submitted within 24 hours after he/she is informed of his/her unfitness in DME.</p> <p>RME of candidates will be conducted in continuation of DME preferably on the next day of DME.</p>
